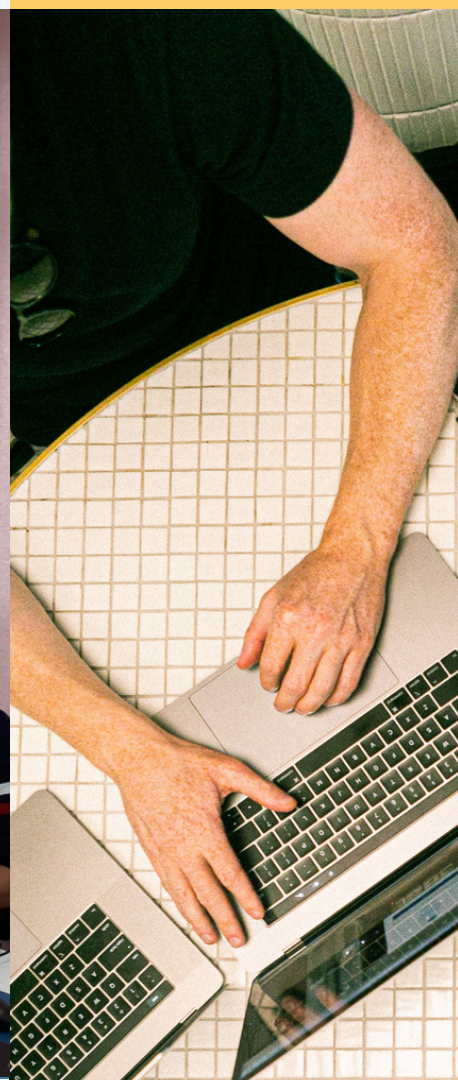

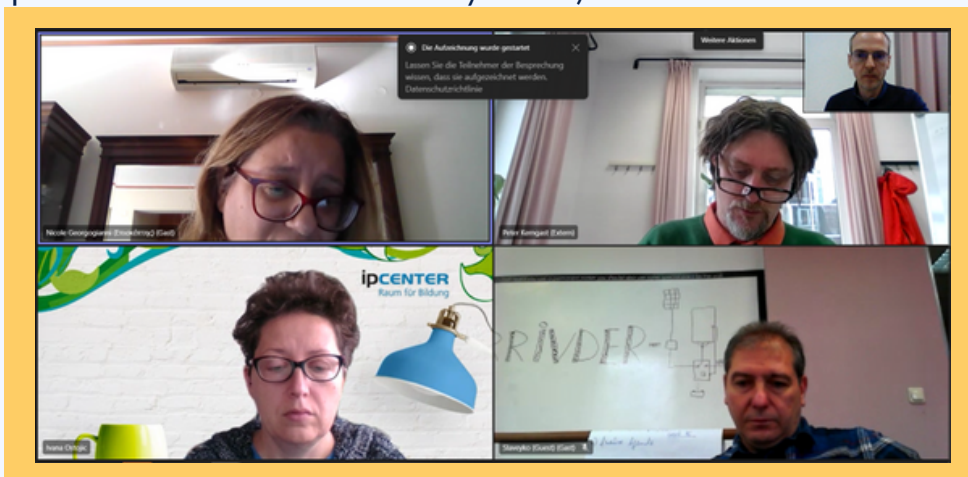

On 7-8 November 2022, the 4th transnational meeting of the DIGISETS project was held in a hybrid format in Sofia, Bulgaria by the local partner ECG. The aim of the meeting was to coordinate the final work on the online evaluation tool (IO2) and the guidebook for trainers (IO3).

The topics discussed were the following:

- Exchange of views and on content and methodology issues by the project partners
- Presentation of the status of the development of IO2 and IO3 by their task leaders, Best Cybernetics and ipcenter, in order to streamline cooperation and deliver the next implementation and completion milestones
- Ongoing dissemination efforts and practical piloting measures within the DIGISETS project, such as face-to-face meetings, web postings and multiplier events (planned in partner countries in February 2023).

TRAINER WORKSHOP

From 23 to 25 January 2023, ipcenter in Vienna, Austria hosted the DIGISETS training workshop (LTTA). Trainers and guidance counsellors from Austria, Greece, and Bulgaria participated in order to review and evaluate the first two deliverables of the project, the competency framework (IO1) and the online evaluation tool (IO2). The main goal of the workshop was to obtain practical feedback from practitioners, suggestions for improvements from the end users of the IOs, as well as to discuss possible further use cases of the DIGISETS evaluation tool in real-life VET training and counselling situations with jobseekers.

In addition, the working group made a study visit to a training center of Weidinger & Partner, a close partner company of ipcenter, where we were shown training facilities such as a restaurant kitchen, cafeteria, bar, and hotel. The visit was a great opportunity to discuss with VET trainers the possibilities of using our evaluation tool in career guidance and qualification measures in the future.

GUIDEBOOK FOR TRAINERS

After the completion and piloting of the digital evaluation tool (with real-life workplace scenarios) - IO2, project partners have been working on the IO3, the guidebook for trainers. It is the final DIGISETS output and provides instructions on how to use project content and tools in everyday work with employees and job seekers.

The Guidebook will serve as a guideline on how to operate the online tool in classroom and individual settings and describes needs and usecases. Also, it summarises the theoretical framework of DIGISETS project, such as the EQF levels, the DigComp 2.2. AT framework, and gives and elaboration of the situations covered in the tool.

The guidebook is co-produced and further improved by project partners and input from VET trainers from Austria, Bulgaria, Greece, after the LTTA.
